
Total Employed - All Industries vs Oil Prices (WTI)




Unemployment Rate - Alberta







Economic Growth (GDP) Alberta - Forecast




Oil Prices WTI - Forecast




Employment Alberta - Forecast


Employment Forecast: Support Activities Oil & Gas Extraction




Employment Forecast: Petroleum and Coal Products Manufacturing








